General Assembly Scholarship Applications Available

West Chicago... Applications are currently available for residents of the 55th Legislative District who may be interested in applying for an Illinois General Assembly Scholarship, state Rep. Randy Ramey (R-Carol Stream) announced today.

The Illinois General Assembly Scholarship Program allows for each legislator to provide scholarship opportunities to residents of their district who have been accepted to and plan on attending any in-state public university of their choice in the upcoming academic year, including:

Chicago State University in Chicago
Governors State University in Park Forest
Northern Illinois University in DeKalb
Western Illinois University in Macomb

Southern Illinois University in Carbondale/Edwardsville

“These scholarships allow me to help hard-working local students afford to go to college,” said Ramey. “Each year, I have the privilege of awarding eight one-year scholarships to individuals from my district to attend any of Illinois’ public universities to further their education”

Ramey explained that there will be five criteria by which applicants will be assessed by an independent scholarship committee: academic performance, community service, extra curricular activities, a 1-2 page essay and financial need.

“I encourage anyone interested in pursuing their education, whether it is a graduate or undergraduate degree, to apply for a scholarship,” said Ramey.
